This course is aimed at those players who have little knowledge of their instruments but would like to know how all the component parts work. Sometimes our tutor Paul Flannery has been able to fix problems during the course saving the cost of sending it for repair.

Morning session

Afternoon session

2pm – 5.30pm Refreshments provided during the afternoon

During the day the working parts of the accordion will be explained and how the treble and bass switches work and the common problems you may encounter. Also reed block configurations, voices, how to undertake minor repairs, including valve replacement, sticky keys and switches, changing bellows gasket and general fault finding. Any instruments brought along needing attention can be used as an example for pinpointing a problem. If it cannot be fixed during the course a diagnosis and assessment can be given. During the day some practical work will be possible. Materials are provided. There will be an overview on how accordions are tuned. Participants should bring a note pad for their own reference notes. Questions on any aspects can be fielded throughout the day.

Cost for the 1 day course is £150
